




High School Graduation Rates - Education Access and Quality

Education access and quality is one of the five domains identified in the social determinants of health (SDoH). SDoH are non-medical factors that influence health outcomes.¹ The conditions in the environment where people are born, live, learn, work, play, worship, and age affect a wide range of health, functioning, and quality-of-life outcomes and risks.²

SUMMARY

- Minnesota's average high school graduation rate in 2018-19 was 83%, lower than the US average graduation rate of 86%.
- The Quin 5-year average graduation rate from 2017 through 2021 was 93.2%. Overall, the graduation rate in a majority of the school districts was higher than the state average.
