



HUNTING SAFETY

Hunters

- Make sure your Hunting License is up to date and your DNR Firearms Safety Certification is completed.
- Wear blaze orange or blaze pink on hats, gloves, and outer clothing worn above the waist.
- Check the weather ahead of time and dress accordingly.
- Familiarize yourself with the area where you will be hunting.
- Notify someone of where you will be and when you will return.
- Keep the gun's safety on until you are ready to shoot.

Non-Hunters

- Know when hunting season is and where it takes place.
- Wear bright colors when in and around the woods.
- Make your presence known to hunters by whistling or caring on a conversation.
- Once hunters know you are present, be courteous and avoid extra noise that may disturb wildlife.
- Avoid certain areas if being around hunters makes you uncomfortable.

Make sure hunting and outside dogs are wearing orange as well.
