



CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY

INSTALLING YOUR CAR SEAT

Find the right car seat for your child's age, height, and weight.

Read and follow the car seat manual for proper installation.

Make sure the car seat is properly anchored down to the seat.

Tighten the anchor straps. The seat should not move more than one inch from side to side or front to back.

Some car seats have an angle indicator. Based on your manual, make sure the angle is correct.

MAKING A SNUG FIT

Make sure to buckle all components of the harness.

Tighten the harness until it is snug.

Conduct a pinch test on the shoulder strap. If you are unable to pinch the strap between your fingers, it is safe.

Do not dress your baby or young child in puffy jackets while in a car seat. Big jackets can interfere with a safe and snug fit.

Use close-fitting layers and approved seat cover to keep your child warm.
